Designed by Multiplex women, our Jump Start programs encourage women into construction using our projects as vehicles to educate and inspire.

Through Jump Start, female high school students have the opportunity to spend time with a Multiplex delivery team and build their understanding of the fantastic career opportunities that exist within our industry.

We will soon be running a Jump Start program for trade pathways alongside our John Hunter Health and Innovation Precinct project.

Who is it for?

The John Hunter Health and Innovation Precinct Jump Start program for trade pathways is for students interested in a building trade career such as electrical, plumbing, carpentry or site supervision. It is open to female students in years 10 - 12 who attend school in the Hunter catchment area.

Building trade skills are highly sought after. If you enjoy hands-on work, problem solving and want job security and to earn good money, then a trade career could be for you.

What's involved?

The program is delivered across eight 2-3 hour interactive, discipline-based workshops that include site walks, mentoring sessions and panel discussions.

Workshops will be held on site and out of school hours, monthly from March - August 2024.

Following these workshops, career and work experience opportunities will be available for students interested in continuing their journey with Multiplex or their subcontractors.
