



The NSW Government is investing \$180 million in the Lower Mid North Coast Health Service Project, bringing together the Manning Base Hospital Redevelopment Stage 2 and Forster-Tuncurry health facility projects.

Staff moves starting shortly

Some hospital staff will be making the temporary move to 2 Pulteney Street (the former council office pictured below) early next year so that work can begin on constructing a new three-storey inpatient unit.

Detailed design has been completed for Stage 2 of the redevelopment and the scope includes refurbished and improved inpatient accommodation, as well as improved connectivity across the campus.

We need to make space for the new inpatient unit by demolishing the administration building, mortuary and old fever ward. The tender will be awarded shortly for a builder to undertake this work.

Following some minor improvements in the rented space at 2 Pulteney Street, Community Health staff who do not need to be adjacent to the hospital will be relocated there.

Staff who need to remain on the hospital campus due to direct clinical inpatient engagement will be accommodated on campus.
